

PIKE COUNTY COUNCIL COMMISSARY RESOLUTION 2026-02

**RESOLUTION OF THE PIKE COUNTY COUNCIL OF PIKE COUNTY, INDIANA,
REGARDING JAIL COMMISSARY FUND; DISPOSITION OF MONEY FROM COMMISSARY SALES;
RECONCILIATION OF RECEIPTS I.C. 36-8-10-21**

WHEREAS, Pike County, Indiana is an Indiana county that has a jail commissary that sells merchandise to inmates, a jail commissary fund has been established. This fund is managed by the Pike County Sheriff's Department per I.C. 36-8-10-21 (d)(9)(e).

(d) The sheriff, or the sheriff's designee, at the sheriff's or the sheriff's designee's discretion and without appropriation by the county fiscal body, may disburse money from the fund for:

(9) any other purpose that benefits the sheriff's department that is mutually agreed upon by the county fiscal body and the county sheriff. Money disbursed from the fund under this subsection must be supplemental or in addition to, rather than a replacement for, regular appropriations made to carry out the purposes listed in subdivisions (1) through (9) addressed in Pike County Resolution 2026-____.

(e) The sheriff shall maintain a record of the fund's receipts and disbursements. The state board of accounts shall prescribe the form for this record. The sheriff shall semiannually provide a copy of this record of receipts and disbursements to the county fiscal body no later than the following dates:


- (1) January 15, for the quarter ending December 31 of the preceding year.
- (2) April 15th, for the quarter ending March 31 of a year
- (3) July 15th, for the quarter ending June 30 of a year
- (4) October 15, for the quarter ending September 30 of a year
