CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Commissioner's President Mark Flint called the meeting to order. Commissioner Ryan Coleman was also present. Commissioner Jeff Nelson was on vacation. County Attorney Val Fleig was not in attendance. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR March 7, 2022

President Flint asked for any additions or corrections in the March 7^{th} meeting minutes. Hearing none he called for a motion to approve the minutes. Commissioner Coleman seconded by Commissioner Flint motioned to approve the minutes. Motion passed 2-0.

APPROVAL OF CLAIMS FOR MARCH 21, 2022

Commissioner Flint called for a motion in regard to claims. Commissioner Coleman seconded by Commissioner Flint motioned to approve the March 21st claims. Motion passed 2-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Appointments - This item was tabled.

NEW BUSINESS

Auditor Request for Credit Card

Auditor Gumbel explained that many of the purchases made by her department would be expedited if they could be done online. Therefore, she requested a credit card with German American Bank.

Commissioner Coleman seconded by Commissioner Flint motioned to approve the request to obtain a credit card with GAB. Motion passed 2-0.

BUSINESS BY COMMISSIONERS

Commercial Insurance Claims Procedure

Commissioner's Assistant Kristi Dischinger explained that this was a new policy to help combat the rising prices of the County's Commercial Insurance premiums and the stringency of

underwriting criteria. These include property, auto, inland marine, linebacker, law enforcement liability and umbrella coverage. The policy states:

- A. Claims with damage less than \$2,000 shall NOT be turned into insurance.
- B. Claims with damage less than the applicable deductible shall NOT be turned into insurance.
- Claims shall be reported to the commissioners' office within 48 hours of incident.

Commissioner Coleman seconded by Commissioner Flint motioned to approve the "County Policy on Submittal of Insurance Claims." Motion passed 2-0.

Trash Site Attendant New Hire

Ms. Dischinger explained that she is one short on needed Trash Site Attendants. Her request is to hire David Pasquino for the part-time position. Commissioner Coleman seconded by Commissioner Flint motioned to approve the hire. Motion passed 3-0.

Clerk/Treasurer Monthly Reports

The reports for February were available for the Commissioners' review.

COVID Updates

Ms. Dischinger reported on behalf of the County Health Nurse.

The number of active cases is two. The total number of diagnosed cases is 3,721. The positivity rate is 2.2% and the number of fully vaccinated citizens is 5,144. This is great news.

BUSINESS BY PUBLIC

President Flint asked the department heads if they had anything to share. Highway superintendent Byrd stated that everything was going well. He said there are two bridges that need to be worked on. He said that he has quotes, but can't start on the job just yet. Highway is currently working in Dodge City where the road was washed out by the river.

John Rogers thanked the Commissioners for the work that had been done to his local roads. He also stated that with the mowing season ready to start he wanted to remind the county that when the Coleman Cemetery was given to the County one of the requisites was to put a \$5 or \$10 bouquet in the cemetery every year. He stated that the price of the bouquet was a bit outdated. The commissioners were unaware of this agreement but said that they would look into it.
